FAQ – Fact Sheet for April 13, 2019

What time should I arrive?

Doors will open at 9am for check-in, at Trinity Church – 7002 Canton Ave.

Here's a general timeline for the service project:

9:00am – Doors Open (Check-in, t-shirts, refreshments)

9:15am – Launch Brief Begins

9:30am – Breakout into Worksite Groups

9:45am – Depart to worksite locations

Waterside Village Apartments will drive to

TCS Middle School Parking (6701 University Ave.)

For safety we recommend crossing University Ave. at the light. Go north on Canton to 66th Street, turn right to the intersection with light.

After parking, catch a tram ride into the Waterside Village Apartments.

Leftwich Park Neighborhood Clean-Up

Catch the bus from Trinity to Leftwich Park

Quad 1, Quad 2, and Quad 3 – Canvas Team & Neighborhood Pickup
Walk/drive to neighborhood.

Prayer Team – stay on Trinity Campus and meet in the Chapel for prayer. Individuals are welcome to join worksite teams, too!

10:00am - Begin Loving Lubbock Audaciously

11:30am - Return to Trinity Church for debrief

How do I know what project I will be working on?

Unless it has been previously communicated to you.... YOU GET TO PICK! We will introduce the project opportunities during the Love Lubbock Launch and the leaders. When we breakout you can identify which area best suits your desire. If you are serving as a family. We request that no minors go to a home unaccompanied. All contacts need to be made in teams of 3-5 people.

How can I get my t-shirt?

T-shirts can be picked when you check-in on Saturday morning in Trinity Central.

What if I get thirsty or hungry?

We will have water bottles/snacks available in Trinity Central when you arrive. Feel free to pack a few for the journey. There will also be water and snacks available at each project site. NEED COFFEE? We'll have a coffee station setup in Trinity Central! Feel free to bring your own cup to fill.

Where do I go if I need to use the restroom?

We highly encourage a "last stop" potty break before everyone heads to their worksites. However, in the case of an emergency the follow bathroom options will be open:

Waterside Village Apartments: Go down the alley between the apartments and the backside of TCS Middle School, to the door with a sign that says "Restrooms"

Quad 1, Quad 2 Quad 3, Leftwich Park, Prayer Team – Trinity Central at Trinity Church.

My pets love people, can I bring them with me? Please let your furry friends enjoy a day of rest at home. There will be no animals accommodating us on this outreach!

What should I wear? The forecast calls for a high of 45 degrees and low of 31 degrees on Saturday with a 50% chance of rain. We recommend comfortable shoes, warm layers and protection from rain.

Who do I contact in case of an emergency? If necessary, call 911 immediately. There will also be safety officers available at each worksite. Please let your team leader know you need help and the safety officers will be there as soon as possible.
