
What concerns parents most regarding online dangers:





Blocking:

Setup Restrictions on Device Restrict what the child can do on phone "Free"

On your iPhone:

- Launch the Settings app on your iPhone or iPad.
- Tap on General.
- Tap on Restrictions.
- Tap on Enable Restrictions if you don't have them enabled already. ...
- Choose a 4-digit passcode that only you will know.





- **2 Types of Parental Systems:**
- 1. Blocking Parental Controls
 - Netsanity iphone or android
- 2. Monitoring calls and texts
 - TeenSafe






Blocking: Parental Controls - Netsanity



Mobile Responsive Admin Portal The dashboard gives parents complete remote access with a few clicks of a button.




Monitoring: TeenSafe









Ask To Buy



Require approval from a parent for all purchases initiated by in the iTunes, iBooks, and App Store.

Children under 13 cannot be removed from a family. Learn more...

Random Inspection

- Look at your child's phone and check it out
- Tell them you are going to check things out from time to time with no warning
- Keep child's phone in Master bathroom at night depending on age
- "Don't expect what you don't inspect"





3. Social Media / Apps

Several apps are designed to hide things from parents

Recommendations:

- If your child uses an app, you need to use it as well
- Login to all apps as your child
- Read about the apps








WHAT PARENTS NEED TO KNOW



Parents need to know that *Snapchat* is a popular messaging app that allows teens to exchange user-generated photos, texts, and videos -- as well as to use live video chat. The developer claims that "Snaps" can't be saved within the app and are only viewable for one to 10 seconds before disappearing from the recipient's device, noting that the app notifies the sender if the recipient






Online Gaming – linked to the Porn Industry Gaming Concerns:




