Luke 15:17-24 (NLT)

MASCULINITY

1 Kings 2:2 (NIV)

2 "I am about to go the way of all the earth," he said. "So be strong, show yourself a man,

"A woman simply is, but a man must become. Masculinity is risky and elusive. It is achieved by a revolt from woman, and it confirmed only by other men. Manhood coerced into sensitivity is no manhood at all." –Camille Paglia, American feminist (1947–)

A woman can give birth to a boy, but only another man can make him into a man.

- A boy's image of himself cannot be solely derived from his mother. He needs a male influence.
- All boys must go through a rite of passage into manhood, and only other men can help in that process.
