Mark 9:23 (*NKJV*)

<sup>23</sup> Jesus said to him, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes."

Matthew 8:10 (TEV)

<sup>10</sup> When Jesus heard this, he was surprised and said to the people following him, "I tell you, I have never found anyone in Israel with faith like this.

#### SEVEN STEPS TO BECOMING UNSTOPPABLE!

1. Prayerfully determine your goal and the personal reward you will achieve from it. [losing weight, saving money, getting a better job, becoming an expert in your field, improving your marriage etc.]

Joshua 1:8 (NAB)

<sup>8</sup> Keep this book of the law on your lips. Recite it by day and by night, that you may observe carefully all that is written in it; then you will successfully attain your goal.

2. Get an initial plan of action to achieve your goal. It will be incomplete don't worry you can update it later.

Habakkuk 2:3 (GW)

<sup>3</sup>The vision will still happen at the appointed time. It hurries toward its goal. It won't be a lie. If it's delayed, wait for it. It will certainly happen. It won't be late.

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# 3. Determine the knowledge and skill required while accessing the gaps in your own abilities.

James 1:5 (NLT)

<sup>3</sup> If you need wisdom, ask our generous God, and he will give it to you. He will not rebuke you for asking.

# 4. Enlist others with the knowledge to fill those gaps.

Galatians 3:3 (NIV)

<sup>3</sup>Are you so foolish? After beginning with the Spirit, are you now trying to attain your goal by human effort?

## 5. Humble yourself and be willing to learn from others.

"The only true wisdom is in knowing you know nothing." - Socrates "It's what you learn after you know it all that counts." - John Wooden

James 4:10 (NKJV)

<sup>10</sup>Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall exalt you.

## 6. Update your plan on your newly acquired knowledge.

Proverbs 21:5 (CEV)

<sup>5</sup>If you plan and work hard, you will have plenty; if you get in a hurry, you will end up poor.

## 7. Execute the plan anticipating adjustments along the way.

Proverbs 16:9 (GW)

<sup>9</sup>A person may plan his own journey, but the LORD directs his steps.
