**WHY I... GIVE**February 1 & 2, 2014

What is the secret to happiness? Tithing.

I don't give because I am happy. I am happy because I give.

Genesis 14:18-24 (NKJV)

Then Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine; he was the priest of God Most High. <sup>19</sup> And he blessed him and said: "Blessed be Abram of God Most High, Possessor of heaven and earth; <sup>20</sup> And blessed be God Most High, Who has delivered your enemies into your hand." And he gave him a tithe of all. <sup>21</sup> Now the king of Sodom said to Abram, "Give me the persons, and take the goods for yourself." <sup>22</sup> But Abram said to the king of Sodom, "I have raised my hand to the LORD, God Most High, the Possessor of heaven and earth, <sup>23</sup> that I will take nothing, from a thread to a sandal strap, and that I will not take anything that is yours, lest you should say, 'I have made Abram rich'-- <sup>24</sup> except only what the young men have eaten, and the portion of the men who went with me: Aner, Eshcol, and Mamre; let them take their portion."

## Why I Give?

- 1. At the age of 20, back in 1983, The Lord spoke to me through a similar message. I responded in obedient faith. I have never missed a tithe check!
- 2. If we are not giving, we don't have a hold of our money. It has a hold of us.

- 3. If I can't trust God with my money, how can I trust him with my soul?
- 4. I don't give to get God to love me. I give because I know He already loves me.
- 5. If I can't live off 90% of my income, I can't live off a 100% of my income.

## Why Some Don't Give?

- 1. I need it more than the church does.
- 2. I can't afford to give.
- 3. God understands, He loves me no matter what.
- 4. Tithing isn't part of the New Testament. God's standards from the Old Testament are raised not lowered in the New Testament.
