

## **SERMON NOTES**

**SON OF GOD -** *Son of Man* Pastor Carl Toti March 29-30, 2014

## Mark 2:1-12 (NLT)

<sup>1</sup> When Jesus returned to Capernaum several days later, the news spread quickly that he was back home.<sup>2</sup> Soon the house where he was staying was so packed with visitors that there was no more room, even outside the door. While he was preaching God's word to them, <sup>3</sup> four men arrived carrying a paralyzed man on a mat.<sup>4</sup> They couldn't bring him to Jesus because of the crowd, so they dug a hole through the roof above his head. Then they lowered the man on his mat, right down in front of Jesus.<sup>5</sup> Seeing their faith, Jesus said to the paralyzed man, "My child, your sins are forgiven." <sup>6</sup> But some of the teachers of religious law who were sitting there thought to themselves, <sup>7</sup> "What is he saying? This is blasphemy! Only God can forgive sins!" <sup>8</sup> Jesus knew immediately what they were thinking, so he asked them, "Why do you question this in your hearts?<sup>9</sup> Is it easier to say to the paralyzed man 'Your sins are forgiven,' or 'Stand up, pick up your mat, and walk'? <sup>10</sup> So I will prove to you that the Son of Man has the authority on earth to forgive sins." Then Jesus turned to the paralyzed man and said, <sup>11</sup> "Stand up, pick up your mat, and go home!" <sup>12</sup> And the man jumped up, grabbed his mat, and walked out through the stunned onlookers. They were all amazed and praised God, exclaiming, "We've never seen anything like this before!"

**Big Idea:** Many of us have a hard time asking for help as well as offering help. It's apart of our human condition.

The rugged refusal of help, is called "the Kursk Syndrome."
