TOGETHERNESS OF THEIR PRAYER Acts 4:32-37 (NKJV)

Now the multitude of those who believed were of one heart and one soul; neither did anyone say that any of the things he possessed was his own, but they had all things in common.

³³ And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And great grace was upon them all. ³⁴ Nor was there anyone among them who lacked; for all who were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the proceeds of the things that were sold, ³⁵ and laid them at the apostles' feet; and they distributed to each as anyone had need. ³⁶ And Joses, who was also named Barnabas by the apostles (which is translated Son of Encouragement), a Levite of the country of Cyprus, ³⁷ having land, sold it, and brought the money and laid it at the apostles' feet.

Together: Greek Word Transliteration: homothymadon

This word denotes the inner unity of a group of people engaged in an externally similar action. It can thus be rendered "with one mind."

This word is used only eleven times in Scripture.

Ten of those times are found in Acts, one is found in Romans.

Together in prayer (Acts 1:14; Acts 4:24).

Together in one place (Acts 2:1).

Together in daily worship and the Lord's supper (Acts 2:46; Acts 5:12).

Together in obedience (Acts 8:6).

Together in a business meeting (Acts 15:25).

Togetherness is needed to glorify God (Romans 15:6).

STRENGTH IN NUMBERS

Proverbs 6:6 (NLT)

⁶ Take a lesson from the ants, you lazybones. Learn from their ways and become wise! A single ant isn't very impressive but a colony of ants is amazing.

Ant Fact 1: The total weight of all the ants in the world is the same as, if not larger than that of all humans.

Ant Fact 2: Some ants can support up to 100x their own weight upside down on glass.

Ant Fact 3: The largest ant colony ever found was over 6000 Km or 3750 miles wide.

Jesus said in John 17:21, "...that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also may be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me."

TOGETHER IN GRACE & POWER

TOGETHER IN GENEROSITY

³⁴ Nor was there anyone among them who lacked; for all who were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the proceeds of the things that were sold, ³⁵ and laid them at the apostles' feet; and they distributed to each as anyone had need.

Not socialism or communism but generosity. Extraordinary times required extraordinary measures. Jewish converts were being persecuted and discriminated against.

The Bible mandates the right of ownership. It is discovered in the Ten Commandments:

Commandment #7: "THOU SHALT NOT STEAL!"

You have a right to ownership, to your possessions and others do not have a right by force or coercion to take what is lawfully yours and give it to another without your consent.
