#### 5. P\_\_\_\_\_ Speech

#### James 4:13-17 (NLT)

Look here, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we are going to a certain town and will stay there a year. We will do business there and make a profit." <sup>14</sup> How do you know what your life will be like tomorrow? Your life is like the morning fog—it's here a little while, then it's gone. <sup>15</sup> What you ought to say is, "If the Lord wants us to, we will live and do this or that." <sup>16</sup> Otherwise you are boasting about your own plans, and all such boasting is evil. <sup>17</sup> Remember, it is sin to know what you ought to do and then not do it.
