1 Corinthians 2:2 (KJV)

For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and him crucified.

1. ATTENTIVE TO CHRIST

1 Corinthians 2:1-2 (NKJV)

¹ And I, brethren, when I came to you, did not come with excellence of speech or of wisdom declaring to you the testimony of God. ² For I determined not to know anything among you except Jesus Christ and Him crucified.

HOW DO WE KNOW THINGS TO BE TRUE?

First, it requires FAITH. Without faith, you can't know anything or should I say not believe anything. Second, OBSERVATION. Which is a personal experience.

Thirdly, REVELATION. Which is a communicated experience.

Matthew 16:16-17 (TLB)

¹⁶ Simon Peter answered, "The Christ, the Messiah, the Son of the living God." ¹⁷ "God has blessed you, Simon, son of Jonah," Jesus said, "for my Father in heaven has personally revealed this to you—this is not from any human source."

Fourthly, REASON. Reason syntheses: Which is the combination of faith, observation, and revelation.

2. ANXIOUS FOR THE CAUSE

1 Corinthians 2:2-3 (GW)

2 While I was with you, I decided to deal with only one subject—Jesus Christ, who was crucified. 3 When I came to you, I was weak. I was afraid and very nervous.

Galatians 6:14 (NKJV)

But God forbid that I should boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.

Matthew 16:24 (NKJV)

Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me.

3. ASSISTED BY THE COMFORTER

1 Corinthians 2:4-5 (NKJV)

⁴ And my speech and my preaching were not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, ⁵ that your faith should not be in the wisdom of men but in the power of God.
