# Acts 6:1 (NLT)

1 But as the believers rapidly multiplied, there were rumblings of discontent. The Greek-speaking believers complained about the Hebrew-speaking believers, saying that their widows were being discriminated against in the daily distribution of food.

#### **GOD ENJOYS A GROWING CHURCH**

Of the 400,000 plus churches in America, there are only 1800 our size or larger.

Growth is a good thing.

#### Mark 4:28 (NLT)

28 The earth produces the crops on its own. First a leaf blade pushes through, then the heads of wheat are formed, and finally the grain ripens.

## 1 Corinthians 3:6 (NLT)

6 I planted the seed in your hearts, and Apollos watered it, but it was God who made it grow.

#### Acts 6:2 (NLT)

2 So the Twelve called a meeting of all the believers. They said, "We apostles should spend our time teaching the word of God, not running a food program."

Problems arise in the church when prayer and the preaching of the Word take a back seat to meeting social needs.

#### 1 Corinthians 14:40 (NKJV)

40 Let all things be done decently and in order.

# Acts 6:3 (NLT)

3 And so, brothers, select seven men who are well respected and are full of the Spirit and wisdom. We will give them this responsibility.

### Three qualifications of a servant-leader.

#### 1. STANDING

"Well respected."

## 2. SPIRITUALITY.

"Full of the Spirit."

## Acts 6:8 (TLB)

8 Stephen, the man so full of faith and the Holy Spirit's power, did spectacular miracles among the people.

#### 3. SKILL

"Wisdom"

# Acts 6:4 (NKJV)

4 but we will give ourselves continually to prayer and to the ministry of the word.

## Acts 6:5-6 (NLT)

5 Everyone liked this idea, and they chose the following: Stephen (a man full of faith and the Holy Spirit), Philip, Procorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicolas of Antioch (an earlier convert to the Jewish faith). 6 These seven were presented to the apostles, who prayed for them as they laid their hands on them.

# The result of a healthy, unified church:

#### Acts 6:7 (MSG)

7 The Word of God prospered. The number of disciples in Jerusalem increased dramatically. Not least, a great many priests submitted themselves to the faith.
