# Acts 8:27-30 (TLB)

<sup>27</sup> So he did, and who should be coming down the road but the Treasurer of Ethiopia, a eunuch of great authority under Candace the queen. He had gone to Jerusalem to worship <sup>28</sup> and was now returning in his chariot, reading aloud from the book of the prophet Isaiah. <sup>29</sup> The Holy Spirit said to Philip, "Go over and walk along beside the chariot." <sup>30</sup> Philip ran over and heard what he was reading and asked, "Do you understand it?"

<sup>31</sup> "Of course not!" the man replied. "How can I when there is no one to instruct me?" And he begged Philip to come up into the chariot and sit with him.

# **READ GOD'S WORD**

**Intelligently** – enjoy the journey, not just the destination.

**Prayerfully** – ask the Holy Spirit to reveal the divine truth.

Thoughtfully – we must digest the truth of God's Word.

- **Personally** apply the promises and the warnings to yourself.
- Spiritually until the Spirit of God blows through the Scriptures they will remain silent.

# BE GLAD Acts 8:32-35 (TLB)

<sup>32</sup> The passage of Scripture he had been reading from was this: "He was led as a sheep to the slaughter, and as a lamb is silent before the shearers, so he opened not his mouth; <sup>33</sup> in his humiliation, justice was denied him; and who can express the wickedness of the people of his generation? For his life is taken from the earth." <sup>34</sup> The eunuch asked Philip, "Was Isaiah talking about himself or someone else?" <sup>35</sup> So Philip began with this same Scripture and then used many others to tell him about Jesus.

# The Bible is all about JESUS *John 5:39 (NLT)*

<sup>39</sup> "You search the Scriptures because you think they give you eternal life. But the Scriptures point to me!

# Acts 8:36-39 (TLB)

<sup>36</sup> As they rode along, they came to a small body of water, and the eunuch said, "Look! Water! Why can't I be baptized?" <sup>37</sup> "You can," Philip answered, "if you believe with all your heart." And the eunuch replied, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God." <sup>38</sup> He stopped the chariot, and they went down into the water and Philip baptized him. <sup>39</sup> And when they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, and the eunuch never saw him again, but went on his way rejoicing.

# Acts 8:40 (TLB)

<sup>40</sup> Meanwhile, Philip found himself at Azotus! He preached the Good News there and in every city along the way, as he traveled to Caesarea.
