THE BIG IDEA: A personal sin compounds into the sinful behavior of a city (ch. 19), which grows into the sinful behavior of a tribe (ch. 20), which escalates into the sinful behavior of a nation (ch. 21)! On a personal level, a woman is brutally treated and dismembered, and on the collective level the people of God will nearly amputate one of their own tribes.

II Corinthians 11:2 (NKJV)

"For I am jealous for you with godly jealousy. For I have betrothed you to one husband, that I may present you as a chaste virgin to Christ."

Judges 19:30 (NKJV)

30 And so it was that all who saw it said, "No such deed has been done or seen from the day that the children of Israel came up from the land of Egypt until this day. Consider it, confer, and speak up!"

Judges 20:10 (MSG)

10 We'll take ten of every hundred men from all the tribes of Israel (a hundred of every thousand, and a thousand of every ten thousand) to carry food for the army. When the troops arrive at Gibeah they will settle accounts for this outrageous and vile evil that was done in Israel."

Judges 20:11 (NIV)

11 So all the men of Israel got together and united as one man against the city.

Judges 2:10-12 (NLT)

10 After that generation died, another generation grew up who did not acknowledge the LORD or remember the mighty things he had done for Israel. 11 The Israelites did evil in the LORD's sight and served the images of Baal. 12 They abandoned the LORD, the God of their ancestors, who had brought them out of Egypt. They went after other gods, worshiping the gods of the people around them. And they angered the LORD.
