Ephesians 5:1 (NKJV) 1 Therefore be imitators of God as dear children.

THREE IMPORTANT LIFE LESSONS

1. JESUS LEARNED WELL Isaiah 50:4 (NKJV) "The Lord GOD has given Me The tongue of the learned, That I should know how to speak A word in season to him who is weary. He awakens Me morning by morning, He awakens My ear To hear as the learned.

Luke 2:52 (NIV) And Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men.

Hebrews 5:8 (NLT2) Even though Jesus was God's Son, he learned obedience from the things he suffered.

Learning is the key to growth (Deut. 5:1-33) Learning from failure is invaluable (Lam. 3:1-66) Learning requires humility (Lam. 3:27-29)

2. JESUS LIVED WELL John 8:29 (NKJV) And He who sent Me is with Me. The Father has not left Me alone, for I always do those things that please Him."

Many a man thinks he is buying pleasure when he is really selling himself to it. –Benjamin Franklin

1 Corinthians 7:19 (TLB) For it doesn't make any difference at all whether a Christian has gone through this ceremony or not. But it makes a lot of difference whether he is pleasing God and keeping God's commandments. That is the important thing.

Hebrews 11:5 (NLT2) It was by faith that Enoch was taken up to heaven without dying—"he disappeared, because God took him." For before he was taken up, he was known as a person who pleased God.

3. JESUS LOVED WELL John 15:9 (NLT2) "I have loved you even as the Father has loved me. Remain in my love.

Christ loved us in three stages:

Ephesians 1:4 (NKJV) just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love,

2) _______ John 15:13 (ESV) Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends.

1 John 3:16 (NIV) This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers.

3) ______ 1 John 4:19 (ESV) We love because he first loved us.
